

CAMP CARITAS - PARENTS' INFORMATION SHEET

Camp Session 2010: August 2 to August 16 for Boys 12-17

Fee: \$425.00 CDN

Fee includes:

- Meals
- Lodging in cabins
- All the activities (including special trips)

Additional Notes for Parents

The balance of the fee (\$425 - \$25 deposit = \$400) must be paid before June 30th.
The \$25 deposit is non refundable.

Refund policy:

1. Depending on the circumstances (sickness or injury - a doctor's note is required), a \$40 cancellation fee is charged seven days before the first day of camp.
2. In all cases, parents will be notified in advance:
 - a. If your son is being sent home because of sickness or injury, a refund is based on the cost per day effective the day after your son is sent home.
 - b. If your son is sent home as a result of a behavioral issue there is no refund. Cost of the bus trip home will be at the parents' expense.



Since Caritas is a sports/good health environment, it is strictly non-smoking. Offenders will be sent home so please inform your son.

A two week notice of cancellation prior to opening date is necessary for a full reimbursement.

Please remember that Caritas is primarily a sports camp. As a sports camp, a good level of participation, motivation and physical aptitude for sports is required. Boys who are not interested in or unable to participate at all of these levels should not enroll. Caritas is a specialized program. There are other camps with a more general and less stringent program that would be more suitable and enjoyable for your son. If you are doubtful, leave an E-mail to our director for more precise information.

Phoning Home: Campers may not use the phone. A letter from home is welcome or you may phone your son in the morning or during the lunch hours.

What Your Son Should Bring

Medicare Card

On the departure day, each camper must hand over his medicare card to the director.

Clothing, etc.

2 or 3 pairs of sneakers (including old pair as water shoes), t-shirts, socks, etc., several "sweats", jacket, rain poncho, warm sweater, soap and biodegradable shampoo, towels, toothbrush and toothpaste, sleeping bag (we supply the pillows), baseball cap (obligatory) and baseball glove, insect repellent and flashlight.

The campers are discouraged from bringing an overabundance of snack food. Regular snacks are provided.

What your son Should NOT bring

- knives, pocket knives
- negative message t-shirts / magazines
- portable CD or MP3 players (like iPods)
- items of value
